 - High contrast white on black destination signs
 - 5 Green Star rating bus depots (Sherwood and Eagle Farm)
- Better bikeways
 - \$120 million program to build bikeways over 4 years
 - Cycling growing at 6.7% pa
- Active School Travel
 - Reduced single family car trips to and from schools by 18% in 2014
 - Increased walking to school from 20% to 34%
 - 88 000 students and 45 schools now involved


