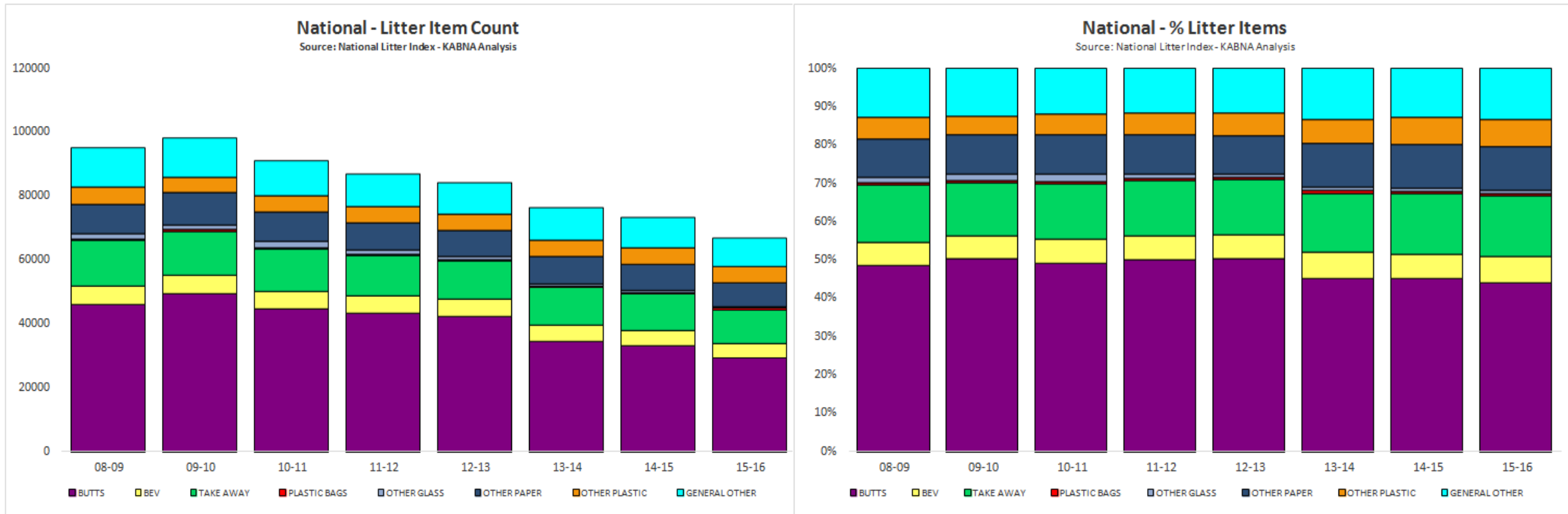

2015/16 Survey Results

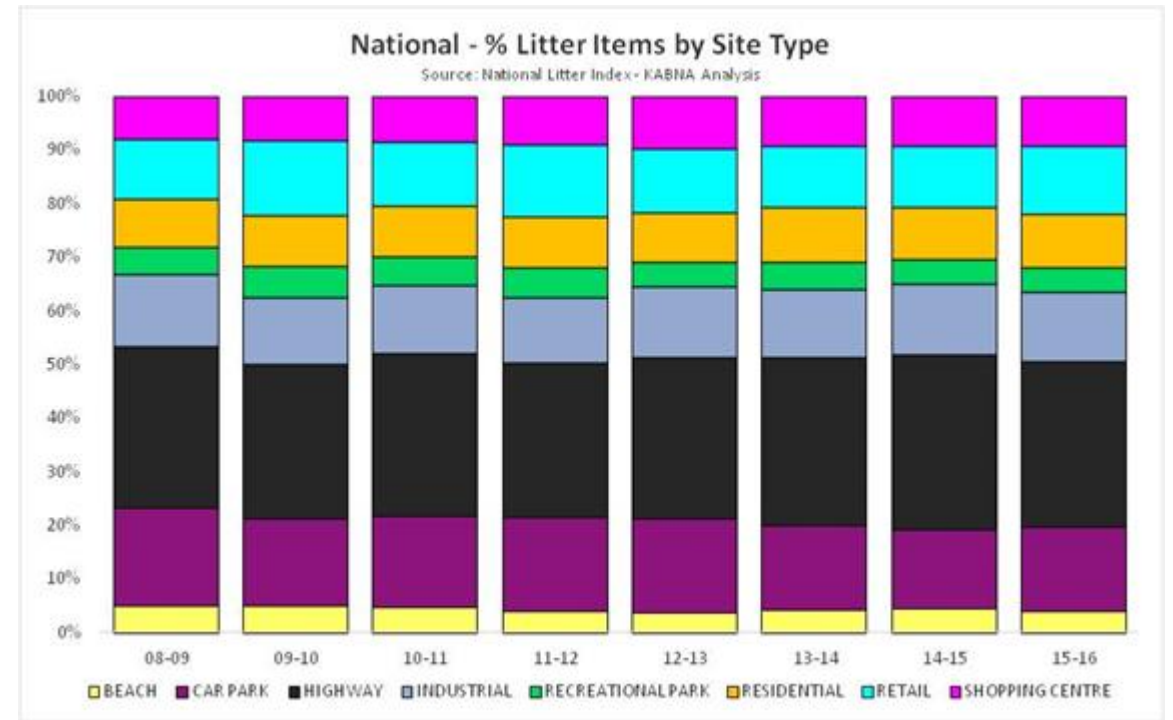
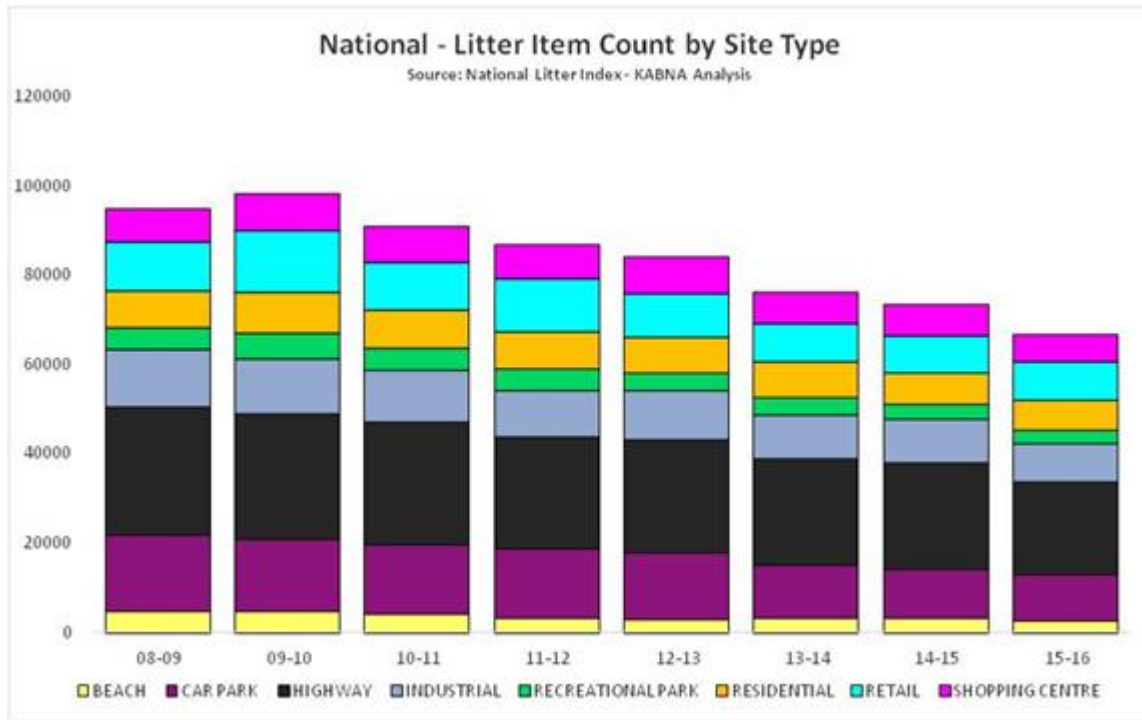
National Overview

The 2015/6 NLI survey of 983 sites across Australia found 9% less litter than seen in 2014/15.

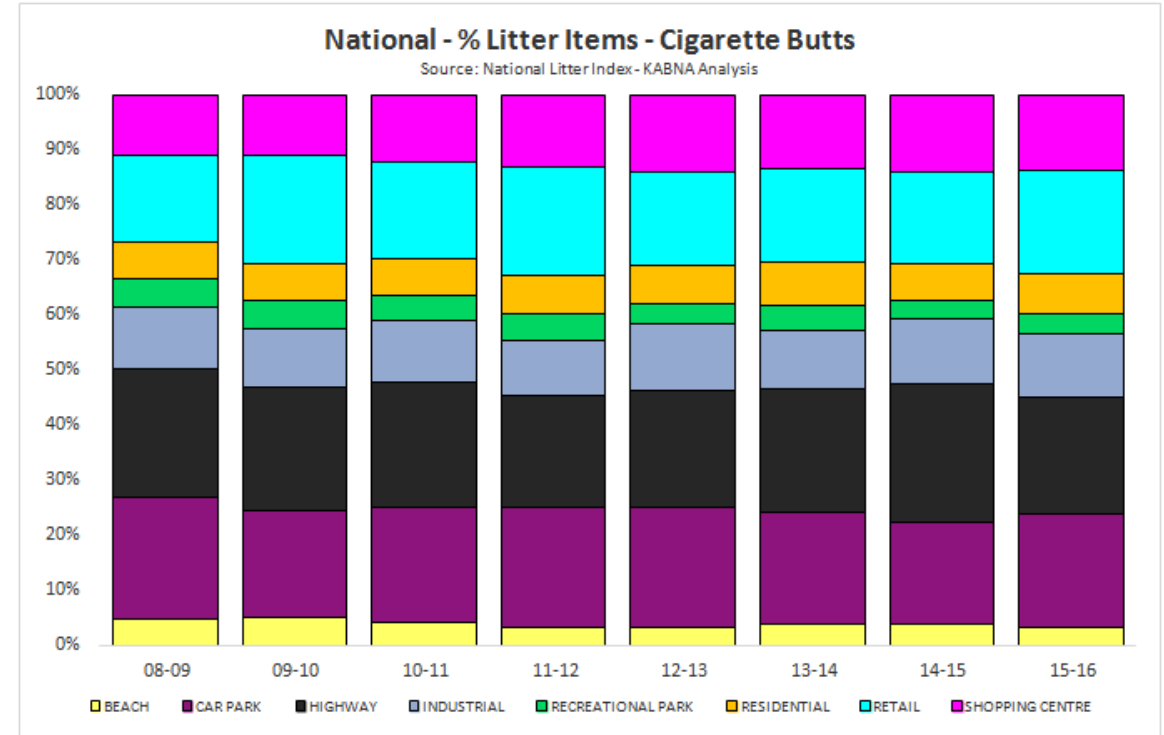
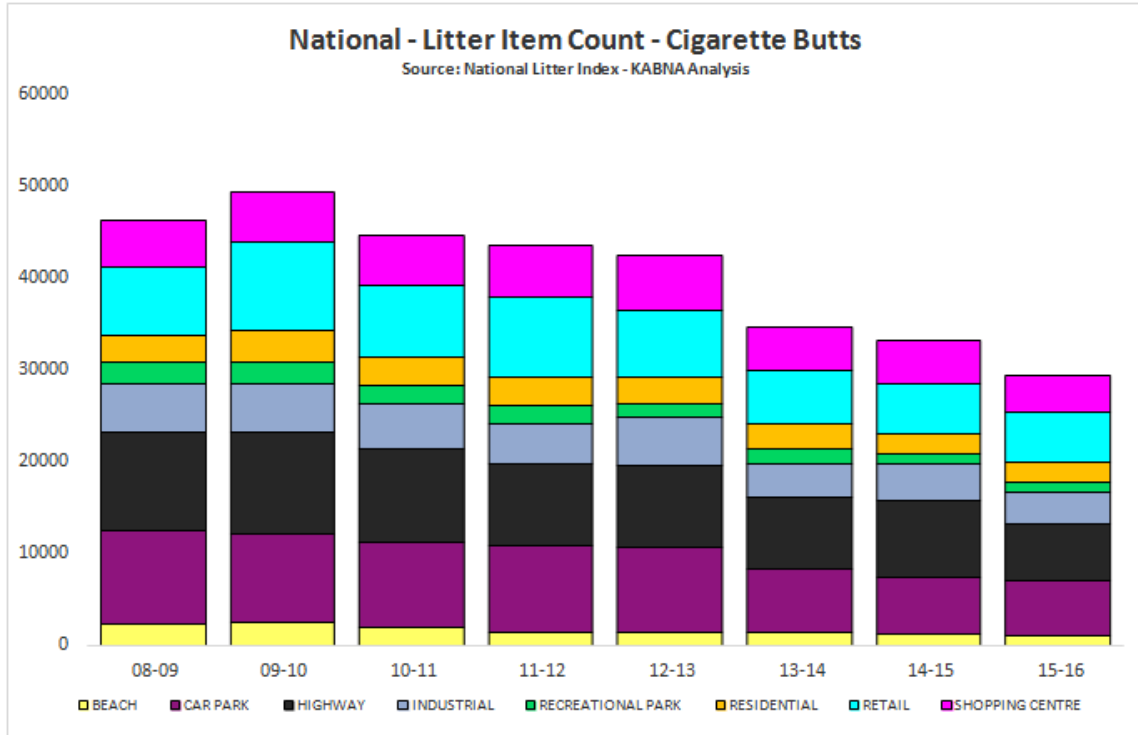
The reduction in counted litter has occurred across all litter types, with little change in the overall shape of the litter stream over the last three years.



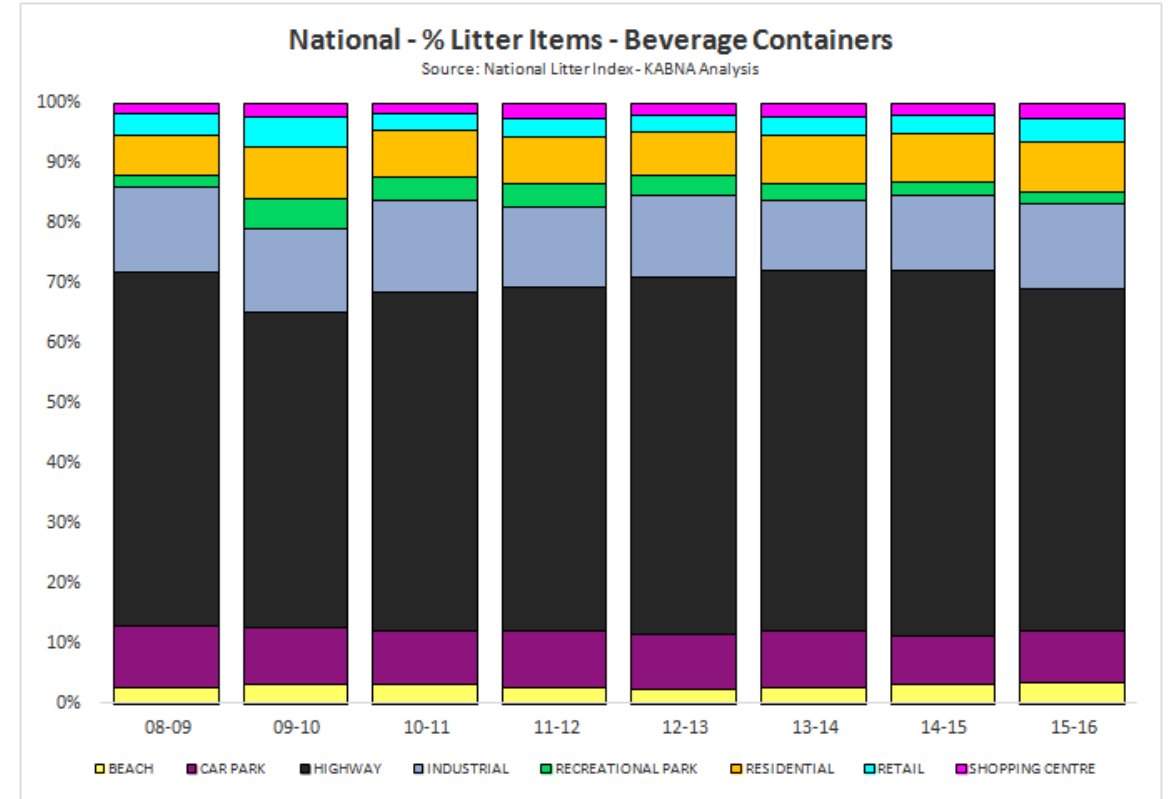
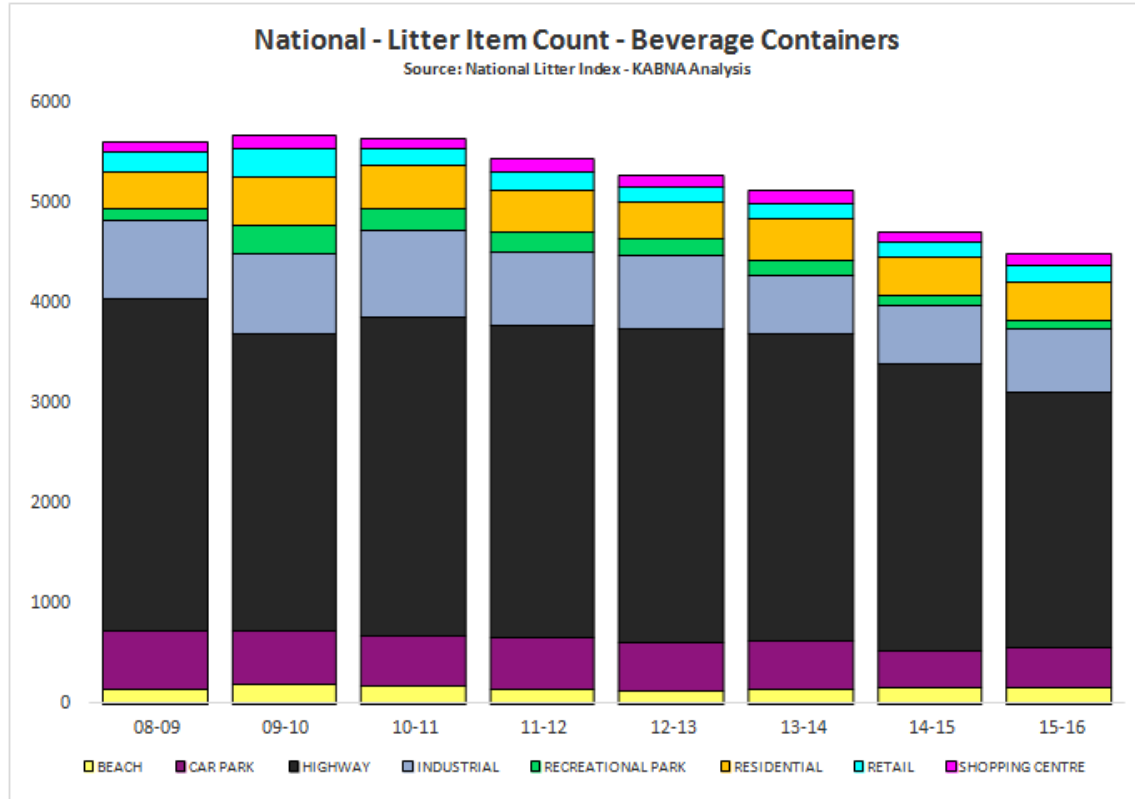
The shape of the litter stream across site types is also relatively stable with the 2015/16 survey indicating proportionately more litter found at retail sites and less on major roads/highways, albeit the changes are small.



We continue to find less cigarette litter across all site types.

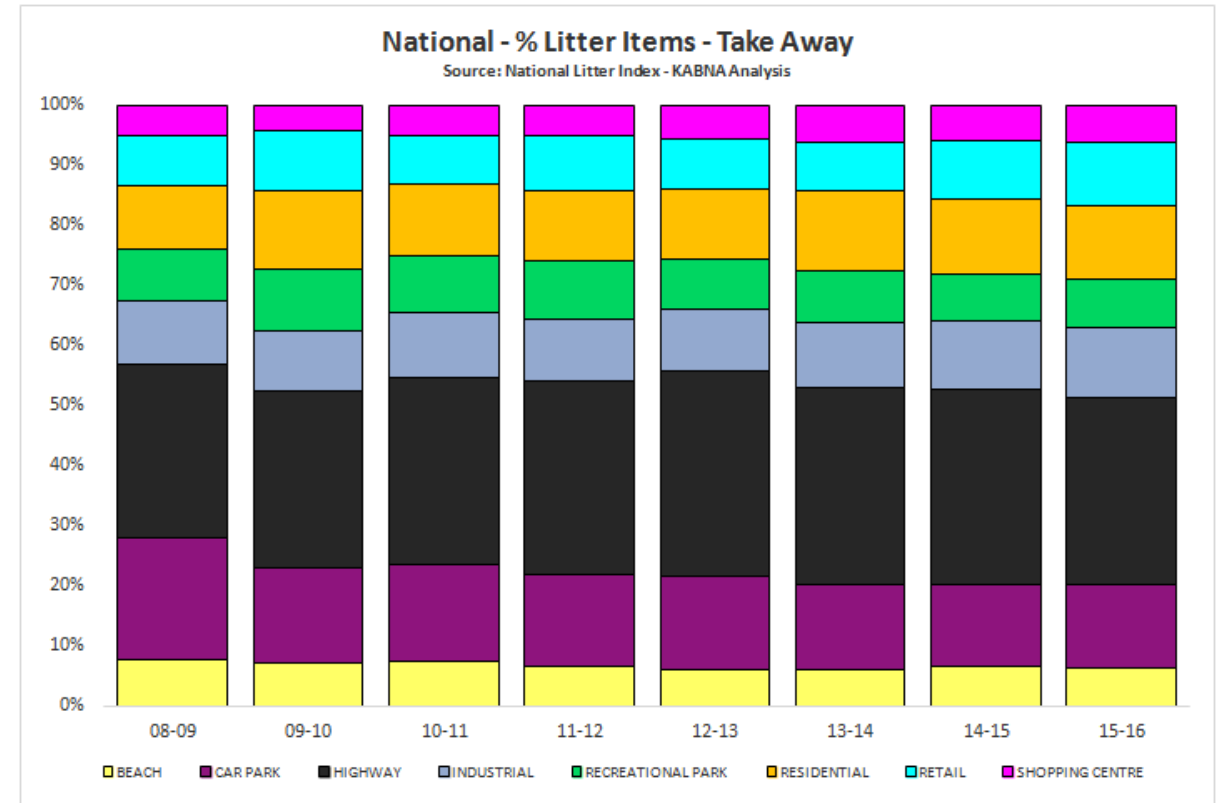
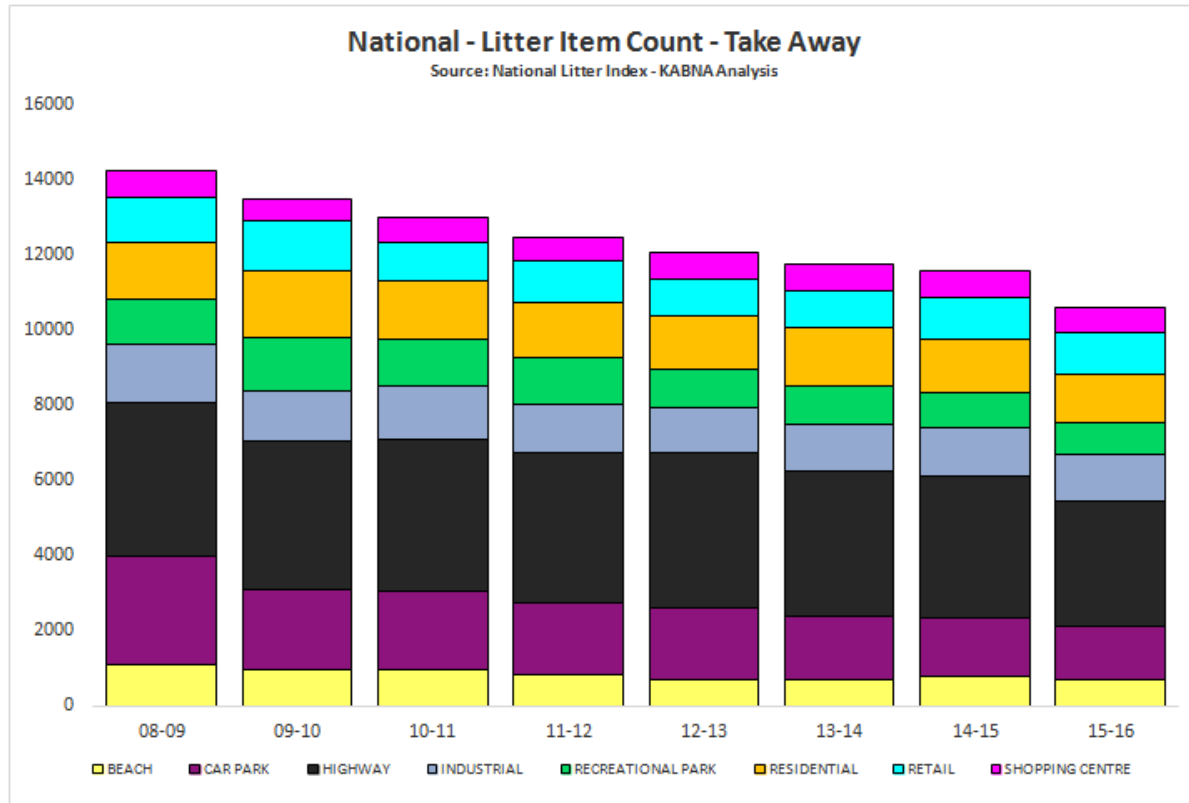


Nationwide, the reduction in beverage container litter surveyed was less on major roads and highways.



Note: Beverage container litter excludes 1litre + fruit juice, wine and spirits, 1litre+ cartons flavoured milk and white milk (all sizes and pack types)

With a similar picture emerging with takeaway food packaging.
