Less Litter, More Recycling Campaign seed funding now available

With support from the Department of the Environment and Energy, we are proud to announce seed funding grants for the Less Litter, More Recycling Campaign.

This year, a limited number of eligible Australian Eco-Schools will receive seed grants of \$300 each to develop and implement a project that reduces litter or improves recycling in their school community.

The campaign targets the behaviour, knowledge and opinion leadership of students. We also hope to see a 10% decrease in the amount of litter and waste production or a 10% increase in the amount of waste diverted to recycling.

Schools will complete their project following the Eco-Schools Seven Steps and conducting two litter audits to monitor progress: One at the beginning of the project and one at the end.
