BRAINSTORMING YOUR MURAL

Coming up with ideas is often the hardest part of being creative but never fear - we have put together this checklist to kick-start your creative thinking!

When you submit your design you will need to show how it connects with your local environment. These are things like:

- Local landmarks such as trees, mountains, rivers that are unique to your area
- Waterways that are used by locals and are a big part of living in your area
- Native animals that are seen in and around the place you live
- Any elements of nature that is special to your school or region.

You can also think about things you have done - or would like to do - to protect your local environment or to make your school more sustainable. Incorporate messages around:
